## - BOTTLES -

**Pilsner Urquell** - Czech Pilsner - 4.4% - Czech Republic.....11.2oz Bottle \$6  
All other Pilsners are a better or worse attempt to copy the original - the first ever Pilsner Urquell.

**Boulevard Whiskey Barrel Stout** - 11.8% - Kansas City, MO.....12oz Bottle \$9  
A riff on the style, this Imperial Stout has coffee and grain notes balanced by date and plum.

**Lindeman's Kriek** - Lambic Fruit - 3.5% - Veizenbeek, Belgium.....12oz Bottle \$13  
Kriek has a pink-red color and a delicious taste of sparkling cherry champagne.

## - CANS -

**Burn 'Em 14 Buck Chuck** - APA - 5.8% - Michigan City, IN.....Pint Can \$8  
Complexity in hop profile, simplistic grain bill, with a variety of hops layered throughout the process.

**Burn 'Em Hop Parade** - IPA - 6.7% - Michigan City, IN.....Pint Can \$8  
IPA brewed and dry hopped with 5 different hop varieties

**Burn 'Em Duke Silver** - Porter - 7.4% - Michigan City, IN.....Pint Can \$8  
Robust, smooth and silky porter that hits notes even the Jazz Man can't describe.

**18th Street Rise of the Angels** - DIPA - 7.7% - Gary, IN.....Pint Can \$8  
Double IPA bursts onto your tongue with a blast of grapefruit zest, followed by floral, citrus hops.

**Warpigs Foggy Geezer** - Hazy IPA - 6.8% - Verona, WI.....12oz Can \$6  
Hazy, fruity, and dry-hopped. This New England style IPA is firm and dank.

**Bell's HopSlam** - DIPA - 10% - Comstock, MI.....12oz Can \$7  
An exceptionally aromatic blend of hops combine in this balanced interpretation of the style.

**Revolution Brewing A Little Crazy** - Belgian Ale - 6.8% - Chicago, IL.....12oz Can \$6  
Citrusy and refreshing Belgian-style pale ale, with Cascade, Citra, and whole Crystal hops.
